IV: Summary of Comments and Responses

(1) Subject Matter: Provisional training license for medical imaging technologists and radiation therapists.

(a) Cyndi Gibbs

Comment: A question was asked...Is the intent of this regulation allowing a person the opportunity to have 24 months to obtain their clinical experiences as outlined by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) which makes them eligible to sit for the ARRT CT exam. Is that the intent of this Board that they want the individual to take the ARRT CT exam by obtaining their clinical experiences in 24 months?

(b) Response: The intent of the regulation is to provide supervised opportunity for licensees to complete clinical competencies in another modality. The determination as to whether the licensee sits for the ARRT CT certification examination within the 24 month time frame is between the licensee and his/her employer.
