		Related legislative activity: None  Related ARRT, ASRT, NMTCB updates: ARRT: a. Beginning Jan 1, 2020, ARRT will begin using a new cut score for NMT exam. The minimum number of correct items necessary to meet the passing threshold will be a few points higher. b. In May 2019, the U.S. Dept. of Veteran's Affairs established qualification standards for Registered Radiologist Assistants. The VA will pursue hiring RRAs in their facilities. c. Beginning no later than 2020, new ARRT ID numbers will be 7 digits rather than 6. Nothing will change for existing 6 digit numbers. d. Recently, the ARRT published that one of the most frequently asked questions was about reporting speeding/traffic tickets to ARRT. If the traffic violation is a felony or misdemeanor, or involved drugs or	
		alcohol, then the violation should be reported to ARRT, and, subsequently KBMIRT.  ASRT: At the June ASRT Board of Directors meeting, discussions ensued about the AAPM's statement recommending the	

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		discontinuation of gonadal and fetal shielding during x-ray procedures. The ASRT stated they "cannot endorse the proposal to remove gonadal and fetal shielding" and believe that "the community needs to conduct more research, review the science and participate in further discussions". The ASRT board plans to meet in the fall to discuss further.	
		NMTCB: Individuals that hold post-primary credentials in nuclear cardiology and PET are required to recertify every 7 years; these individuals now have the option to recertify by obtaining CE related to the specialty field, rather than having to take the exam again. To recertify, the individual would need to complete 6 hours of CE per year of certification (42 hours) or through reexamination.  Budget: July report distributed a. Revenue b. Expenditures c.
